# Can't Make It to the Library?

Free delivery is provided to anyone who lives in Forest Park and is unable to visit the library due to temporary or permanent illness or mobility issues.



## Who is eligible?

Forest Park residents with a library card who are unable to visit the library due to temporary or permanent illness or a mobility issue. If you are uncertain if you are eligible, just ask.

## How do I get library items delivered?

Complete an application at the Info Desk, by phone (708-689-6125) or online at [fppl.org/homedelivery](http://fppl.org/homedelivery). After your application is reviewed, a staff member will contact you.

## What materials can be delivered?

- Patrons can receive FPPL items as well as items from partner libraries with regular checkout periods.
- Patrons can check out 10 items every two weeks.
- Eligible items include books, DVDs, CDs, audiobooks, hotspots and magazines.

## When do deliveries take place?

Items will be delivered every other Thursday by a staff member or trained volunteer.

## Things to Know

- This service is free of charge.
- The Library is fine free. Find out more about the program at [fppl.org/finefree](http://fppl.org/finefree).
- Lost and damaged items will incur a replacement fee.
- Patrons will become ineligible for the service if they do not return library materials or move out of Forest Park.

The Home Delivery program can be discontinued for any reason.
